STATISTICS

This section contains some raw statistics without comment. A list of the species group names proposed by decade is listed in the table below followed by a graph of the numbers. Allowance must be made in interpreting the graph for the truncated decades at the beginning and end of the graph. The tables on the following page are a break down of numbers of species and names by family. Despite claims in volume 1 that the Staphylinidae are the largest family of North American insects, the Ichneumonidae are now the clear winner in the numbers department with approximately 4700 currently recognized valid species.
